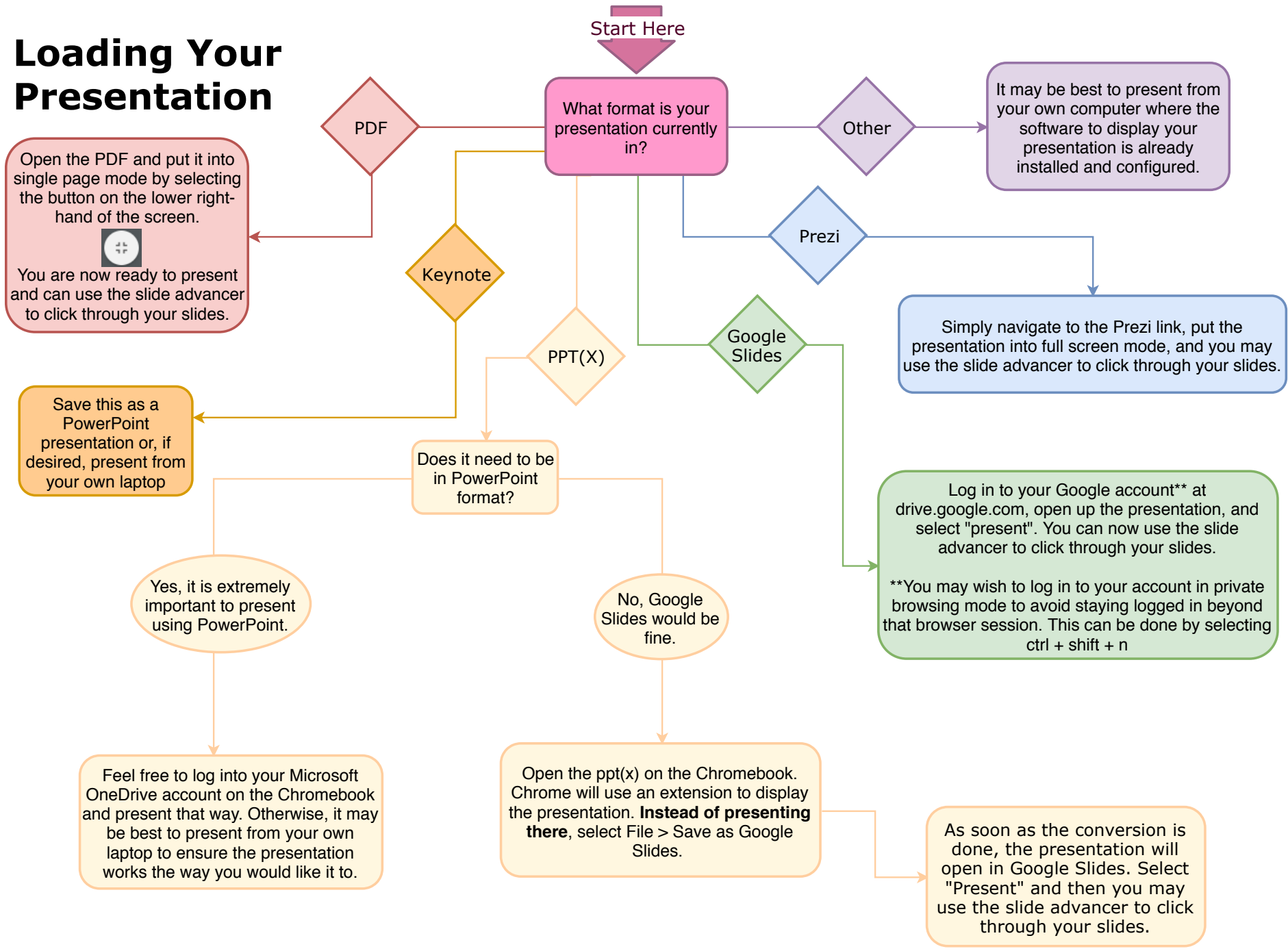


Loading Your Presentation

What format is your presentation currently in?

PDF

It may be best to present from your own computer where the software to display your presentation is already installed and configured.

Open the PDF and put it into single page mode by selecting the button on the lower right-hand of the screen.



You are now ready to present and can use the slide advancer to click through your slides.

Prezi

Simply navigate to the Prezi link, put the presentation into full screen mode, and you may use the slide advancer to click through your slides.

Save this as a PowerPoint presentation or, if desired, present from your own laptop

Does it need to be in PowerPoint format?

Log in to your Google account** at drive.google.com, open up the presentation, and select "present". You can now use the slide advancer to click through your slides.

**You may wish to log in to your account in private browsing mode to avoid staying logged in beyond that browser session. This can be done by selecting ctrl + shift + n

Yes, it is extremely important to present using PowerPoint.

No, Google Slides would be fine.

Feel free to log into your Microsoft OneDrive account on the Chromebook and present that way. Otherwise, it may be best to present from your own laptop to ensure the presentation works the way you would like it to.

Open the ppt(x) on the Chromebook. Chrome will use an extension to display the presentation. **Instead of presenting there**, select File > Save as Google Slides.

As soon as the conversion is done, the presentation will open in Google Slides. Select "Present" and then you may use the slide advancer to click through your slides.
