Background

- Context of Message Important to Many User Agents (UA)
- Message Context Implies Certain Expectations By Users
 - "Voice Mail is More Important Than Bulk E-Mail"
 - "Page / SMS is More Important Than Voice Mail"

Intelligent UA Processing

- Context Can Give Hint to Mail Transfer Agent (MTA) How to Handle Delivery
- Context Can Give Hint to User Agent (UA) For User Indication of Message Type (e.g., Icon, Sorting of Inbox, etc.)
- Context Can Give Hint to UA for Presentation

Autodetection Not Sufficient

- Is a Message Composed of a
 - Text Part
 - Audio Part
 - Image Part
- A Text Message With Voice Annotation and a "Nifty" Stationary JPEG?
- A Music File With the Albumn Cover and Liner Notes?

Even Obvious Isn't Really

- Is a Message Composed of a text, audio/g726, image/tiff-f
 - A Fax Message With a Voice and Text Annotation?
 - A Text Message With an Attached Scan?
 - A Voice Message Forwarded from an E-Mail UA?
- Cost of Scanning Entire Message Can Be Prohibitive for Service Provider Scale

Need

- Method of Identifying Message as Belonging to a (small number of) Enumerated Message Classes
 - Such That It Does Not Require Scanning the Entire Message
 - Such That It Is Extensible
 - Such That Mismarked Messages Are Still Deliverable

Approach

- Create Top-Level, RFC 822 Message Attribute, Content-Hint
- Use of Attribute is Local to UA or MTA
 - Presentation / Icons
 - Viewer to Use
 - Reply Composition Tool
 - etc.
- Only a Hint: OK if Wrong

Content-Hint

- Register Content-Hint Types With IANA
- Envisioned Initial Types
 - voice-message
 - fax-message
 - video-message
 - sms-message
 - none
 - X-mumble

Security Considerations

- Spoofing Message Type to Interpret Binary Data
- Don't Willy-Nilly Accept Content-Hint: Application!
- Don't Rely 100% on Content-Hint for Processing
 - Opens Mail Bomb Attack By Sending Small Messages With Wrong Content / Hint
