# Intro

- “Universal Inbox”
  - Combined list of messages containing text, voice, and fax
- Different media types have their own characteristics for user presentation
- Message Hint (Primary Content) field used to indicate whether the email is a text, voice or fax message
- IMAP mechanism suggested where appropriate

# Client Features Mentioned:

- Message Icon
  - Indicates Primary Content
  - Change when message read?
- Sender's Number Column
  - Data comes from “Caller-ID” field (draft-ema-vpim-clid-00.txt)
- Message Size
  - Pages for fax, Seconds for voice, kilobytes for text
  - Size of Primary Content displayed
- Media Viewer
  - Default viewer for Primary Content fired when message opened
- Mark Message Read only if Voice Played

# Future Considerations

- Upisue to include:
  - Message media type indicate priority
    - Voice more urgent than text?
  - Reply, forward (etc.) behaviour
    - E.g. reply to voice with voice?
  - Message filtering
    - Why download fax messages if accessing email from a phone?
