Future steps

- Enhance key requirements and metrics, especially for layer 2 PPVPNs
 - progress in parallel with L2 requirements ID
 - align with L2 solutions work (metrics, etc.)
- Fill out management related sections
- Finalize the classification
 - common, L3 and L2 sections are enough?
 - reduce redundancy (reqts at different levels)
- Alignment with L3 individual AS IDs
- Incorporate list comments, editorial work
- Move to a WG document
