Conclusions and Next Steps

- IPR discussion:
 - Cisco claims cover large parts of the spec. but are vague
 - IPR statement lacks clarity with respect to other licensing (BSD, open source, ...)
 - Show of hands: consensus to continue the current spec.
- NEMO Basic Support: Companion documents are necessary
 - Threat Analysis: we need a WG doc and more extensive analysis
 - URGENT progress on ML is needed
 - Usages:
 - Show of hands concludes WG doc is needed but later,
 - Mailing list: more work, more topics welcome, decide what will be put in
 - Prefix Delegation: we need a draft and decide if it WG draft
- MIB:
 - Authors of draft-ietf-mip6-mipv6-mib-01.txt “The Mobile IPv6 MIB” have shown interest in doing this for NEMO Basic Support when specification is finished
- Multihoming Problem Statement
 - Show of hands: merge the docs and make it WG doc
 - ML: discuss exact contents; decide what scenarios are relevant to NEMO.
