# Status since IETF58

- Nothing has really changed
  - No new draft
  - No discussion on the mailing list
- But... now part of TCPM WG

# RTO adjustment

- When taking multiple RTTMs within one RTT, you must adjust the RTO estimator to take into account the more frequent measurements by decreasing the weighting factor.

# Enabling TS midstream

- Turn on when PAWS is needed
  - short (<2 GB) connections don't need PAWs
- Still negotiate in SYN?
- Begs the general question: “Do most current TCP implementations properly handle unknown options midstream?”
  - In the past, some machines only handled unknown options on the SYN packet

# PAWS & DF BIT

- Should PAWS require that the IPv4 DF bit be set?
  - PAWS protects first fragment
  - Other fragments protected by IP id (16 bits!)
  - TCP checksum should notice
  - Pathological case is ongoing loss of packets due to bad reassembly.

# RTTM from DUP ACK

- Get valid RTTM after idle period, if first packet is lost
- Interoperability issues with current implementations?

# RTTM from DUP ACK: Issues

- Need to copy SEG.TSval to SEG.TSecr in ACK, without updating TSrecent.
  - Updating TSrecent would break PAWS for re-ordered packets
  - One option: Split TSrecent
    - Keep TSrecent for PAWS
    - Add TSecho for what to put into SEG.TSecr for outgoing packets.
    - TSecho same as TSrecent except when out-of-order data received

# RTTM from DUP ACK: Issues

- Need a definition for “DUP ACK”:
  - 1. the TCP sender has outstanding data, AND
  - 2. the ACK number is the largest seen so far, i.e., it acks `snd_una`, AND
  - 3. the ACK is a pure ACK, i.e., `SEG.LEN == 0`, AND
  - 4. the advertised window info didn't change, i.e., this is *\*not a window update\**.

- HS-TCP and others depend on window scaling
- Eifel depends on Timestamp option
- Should SACK even be discussed?
