### Motivation

- Provides a means to label m= lines in an SDP session description so that they can be referenced
  - The label is a pointer to the m= line
- The scope of the label is wider than the offer/answer exchange
  - E.g., an XML document pointing to an m= line

# Why NOT Using Existing Attributes

- info
  - For display purposes only
  - Not for automata processing
- mid
  - Provides m-line identifiers within the scope of an offer/answer exchange

## Bi-directional Requirement

- Server needs to reference a direction of a media stream
- Possible solutions
  - A single label for both directions
  - A label for each direction
