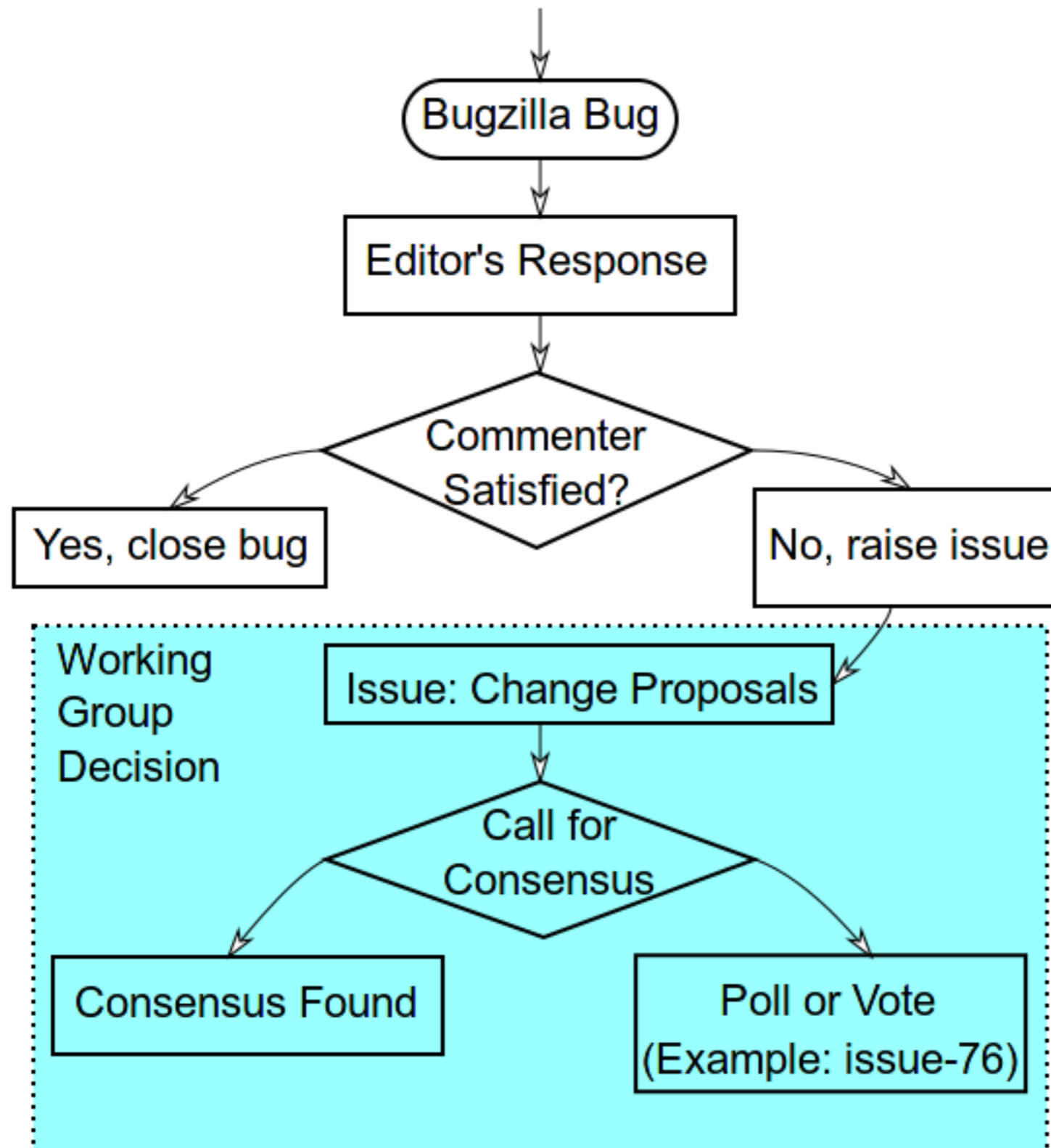

- August 2, 2011: Deadline for submitting Last Call Comments
- January 14, 2012: Deadline for Escalation to issues
- February 11, 2012: All issues have at least one Change Proposal
- April 21, 2012: Next step resolution – New Last Call or Candidate Recommendation
