## Updating multipart/report

## The Issue

- The MARF working group has in its charter the idea of converging as much as possible with the SpamRep effort in the OMA
  - ARF (MARF's base spec) uses multipart/report as defined in RFC3462
  - SpamRep supports one message containing any number of reports
  - RFC3462 disallows this by requiring that multipart/report be the outermost MIME type

## The Proposal

- draft-kucherawy-rfc3462bis
  - Updates RFC3462 (currently DS)
- Only change is to remove the "outermost MIME part" restriction
  - Consensus appears to be that it's not a useful constraint and most implementations ignore it
  - Probably requires a recycle at PS
- Could do so here, then YAM could advance it back to DS when the time comes?
  - Other paths?
