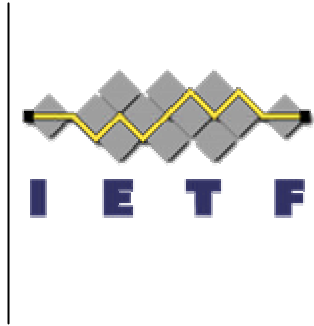
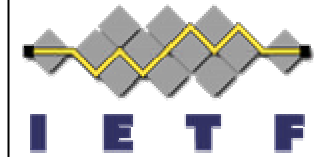


The IETF Mission

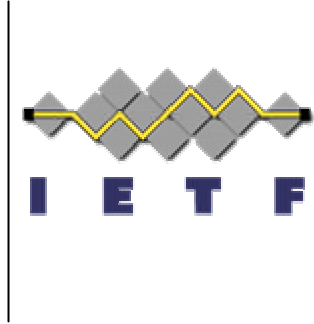


- Is the IETF primarily a standards organization?

IETF Procedure Questions



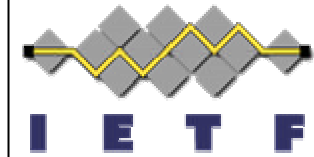
- Is functional differentiation a reasonable theory?
- Are the two selected areas the right ones to tackle first?
 - WG Chair role and procedures
 - Document review – early and often



IETF WG Chair questions

- Does the community think we got it right(er)?
 - Will it make it easier to get the job done?
- Is the WG chair's role right(er)?
 - Do they need more tools or powers?
 - Do they need more support?
- Who wants a job as WG chair? 😊

Document Review Questions



This illustrates the state of the topic – more work needed!

- Do we need more review? YES!
- Early review – what is most needed?
 - Subject matter experts
 - Cross-area review
- Pre-IESG review – what is most needed?
 - Lots of people doing review
 - People who will catch blocking issues
- How should reviewers be selected?
- How should reviewers be trained?
- Who should pick review criteria?
- Who should decide the weight to give to reviews?
