What it is

- Allow a committee to recommend that non-full standards be retired or worked on
- IESG still does yeas and nays
- Still last call to community

Changes since last IETF

- Far more constrained
 - Only standards that are not full get reviewed
 - Category simplification (only historical)

- Larry: concerned that positive rather than negative arguments should be made for a standard to continue

Comments

- Margaret: not saving IESG any real time. Go do something else, please.

Comments

- Johns: perhaps more nuanced approach combined with other work or use of July 14 experiment.

Comments

- Pekka: at least one RFC, even for a batch please.

Eliot's personal view

- Go forward as experiment and consider results by next Summer (Paris IETF). Use existing draft as a guide.
- Consider RFC issue once we have a list (we're arguing too abstractly right now).
