  - In queue at start: 24
  - Received: 12

- December 2004
  - In queue at start: 27
  - Received: 12
  - Completed: 1

# Some Statistics – Drafts w/IANA Actions

- January 2005
  - In queue at start: 38
  - Received: 10
  - Completed: 18
- February 2005
  - In queue at start: 30
  - Received: 16
  - Completed: 22

# Some Statistics – Drafts w/IANA Actions

- Current Status as of 5 March
  - 18 Open documents, including:
    - 3 On hold
    - September/October 2004 – 3 in Author state
    - November/December 2004 – 2 in IANA state
    - November 2004 – 1 in Open state
    - January/February 2005 – 8 in Open state
    - February 2005 – 1 in Author state

# PEN Statistics

- November
  - New requests: 341
  - Assigned: 264
- December
  - New requests: 261
  - Assigned: 126
- January
  - New requests: 268
  - Assigned: 117
- February
  - New requests: 278
  - Assigned: 338

# Since DC

- New request tracking system (RT) on line
  - Internet-Drafts
  - Port number requests
  - PEN requests have a (mostly adequate) system already
  - We are currently discussing adding [iana@iana.org](mailto:iana@iana.org) to RT
- New staff – Barbara Roseman
  - IANA Operations Manager
  - Extensive background in the ICANN community
  - Worked on ICANN strategic plan
  - Held similar position at Global Crossing
  - Will greatly increase management attention on day to day operations, such as our work for the IETF
