Objectives of the prospective WG

- What we want to do
 - List all issues related to mobility and multihoming
 - Identify what are the mobility-specific issues
 - Solve the mobility specific issues by providing straight-forward extensions to mobile nodes:
 - operating MIPv6 (RFC 3775)
 - operating NEMO Basic Support (RFC 3963)
 - Standardize a standard track solution
 - Changes will be limited to MIPv6-and/or-NEMO-enabled nodes
 - Interact with other WGs whenever appropriate

Objectives of the prospective WG

- What we don't want to do
 - Duplicate effort or conflict with other WGs
 - Solving the non MIPv6/NEMO-specific issues
 - Solving multihoming for nodes with no MIPv6 or NEMO BS extensions
 - Discussing long term approaches to solve the overall problem (e.g. separation of ID and locator functions)
