WGLC Summary

- Make extensibility of registration explicit, add:
 - Both the registrar and the requester MAY also include in the messages exchanged additional HIP parameters specific to the registration type implicated. Other documents will define which and how these parameters shall be used.

WGLC Summary

- Establishing credentials is out-of-scope, add:
 - The precise means of establishing and verifying credentials are beyond the scope of this document and are expected to be defined in other documents.

WGLC Summary

- Clarify when to use REG_REQUEST, change:
 - Moreover, the requester MUST NOT include the parameter unless the registrar's R1 packet or latest received UPDATE packet has contained a REG_INFO parameter with the requested registration types.

 Moreover, the requester MUST NOT include the parameter unless the requested service was advertized by the registrar via a REG_INFO parameter included in an R1 or an UPDATE packet.
