Conclusions on WG Items

- WG Item #1 “Scenarios and Motivations for Host Multihoming”
 - Apparent acceptance of draft ernst-generic-goals-and-benefits as draft-ietf-monami6-scen-motivations (20 people read, 40 agree, none oppose. Confirm on ML)
- WG Item #2
 - Apparent acceptance of draft-montavont-mobileip-multihoming-pb-statement as WG item. (15 read, 30 agree, none oppose. Confirm on ML)

Conclusions on WG Items

- WG Item #3
 - Strong acceptance of draft-wakikawa-mobileip-mcoa as a WG item (40 read, 20 accept, none oppose. Confirm on the ML)
 - Should be processed at the same time as WG item #3
- WG Item #4
 - Authors to merge 3 existing drafts into one. Some issues to discuss. Set up issue tracker.
 - MH side OK, need discuss more about MR side
 - Comments on the ML should be considered by₃ authors to improve the merged draft.
