Over the next 18 months, we will enhance and extend our current training activities for participants, document editors and WG chairs, based on community feedback and the judgement of the EDU Team. We will also continue to look for new ways to make instructional material available to the IETF, such as web-based training materials.

We are starting a new educational initiative intended to help participants to bring new work items into the IETF, either into existing WGs or via BoFs and the formation of new WGs. This effort will include the development of informational documentation as well as the development of a new IETF process tutorial.
