 - draft-ietf-mipshop-fmipv6-rfc4068bis-04
 - Document revised to address comments from AD
- HMIPv6
 - draft-ietf-mipshop-4140bis-01
 - Submitted to the IESG recently

- FMIPv6 Security
 - draft-ietf-mipshop-handover-key-03
 - Good progress on this document
 - In the RFC Editor queue currently
 - AAA-based handover keys
 - No document adopted yet
 - Multiple solutions available
 - WG needs to take a decision on the next steps

- FMIPv6 over 3G CDMA network
 - draft-ietf-mipshop-3gfh-04
 - A number of comments from the AD, needs a revision
 - We solicited comments/reviews from 3GPP2, but there was no response
- FMIPv6 over 802.16e networks
 - draft-ietf-mipshop-fh80216e-05
 - A number of comments received from the AD, needs a revision

- MIH Problem Statement
 - draft-ietf-mipshop-mis-ps-05
 - IETF last call ongoing
- MIH Solution
 - Design Team has made good progress
 - New version available
 - Next step is to adopt the document as a WG document

 - AAA based handover key for FMIPv6
 - MIH solution document
