#### NAT Logging - 2

- Ability to write applications to collect the data and process in a generic way
- Vendor agnostic
- Draft does NOT specify the transport protocol to be used to carry the data

- Destination logging optional
- Added IANA registry requirements
- Incorporated other comments

- DSCP bits to be logged?
  - DSCP can be used as a multiplexer
