- Develop and propose data structures and data exchange provisioning protocol between SIP-based multimedia administrative domains
- Specifically,
 - Identify use cases and requirements
 - Specify data model and protocol
 - Specify one transport; agreed upon mechanism is SOAP over HTTP
- There are <u>no current plans</u> to extend the charter (e.g., for distribution) or other transport mechanisms
 - This was clarified in Quebec and re-iterated at the interim
 - However, new work requests can be submitted to DISPATCH
