Major Takeaways from the Interim

- OpenSPP implementation demonstrated "running code"
- However there was a recommendation to change the document split between the protocol and transport docs
 - Specifically, make it even more generic to support additional mechanisms, such as RESTful Web Services
 - Protocol document to contain object definitions; and the normative requirements around operations, response codes and object identity
 - Concrete representations of operations, responses and object identity to go into the transport document
- Barring the absence of objections from the WG, the design team has since proceeded to modify the split
