

Processing

H.E. Syntax Analysis

- Resolving application demands to H.E. parameters
- Resolved parameter may include “Hard” or “Soft” preconditions

Data Delivery

- The parameters have been passed to Kernel
- “Filter” and “Sort” rules are applied

Changes since IETF81 (-02 to -03)

- Elaborated the H.E. MIF framework to cooperate with applications and kernel modules
- Added detail on internal processing and implementation
